MAINTAINING A HEALTHY LIFESTYLE

Maintaining a healthy lifestyle cannot be over-emphasized. It is critical in view of the fast-paced microwave style life that we tend to lead these days. It is especially important if you are challenged by infertility. Part of this healthy lifestyle involves also taking care of our frame of mind, which is influenced a lot by the company that we keep. People influence not only our opinions but also our self-esteem.

- Be wary whom you ask for directions along the road of life. Not everyone will be happy for you and spur you on to succeed;
- Surround yourself with people who have sound morals and are consistent in their behaviour – their walk must match their talk;
- Associate with optimistic people who have an attitude of “to make something out of nothing”;
- Never receive counsel from unproductive people who don't follow their own advice;
- Differentiate between acquaintances and friends – friends will see you through even when others think you're through !



Being told by a gynaecologist that you are infertile is devastating. Many specialists don't use the necessary sensitivity or tact when handing down such test results and couples often leave a gynae's rooms in utter shock, questioning whether their marriage will be able to survive the disappointment. What needs to be remembered is that modern medicine can achieve much today – whether it is a low or poor sperm count in a man to anovulation in a woman. Infertility treatments can cost a couple an arm and a leg. The cost appears to vary from one fertility clinic to another and appears to depend, in part, on the area in which the clinic is located. It would be wise for a couple to discuss their options together and keep focussed on this emotional journey as infertility treatment may not necessarily work after the first attempt.

- a) **Induction of ovulation** – The goal of this treatment is to stimulate ovulation in a woman who doesn't ovulate. The treatment can be simple, such as giving the woman hormone tablets, or it can be more sophisticated with the need for injections.
- b) **Intra Uterine Insemination (IUI)** – In this procedure, the woman is stimulated to ovulate followed by quality sperm being placed in the uterus to allow for natural fertilization.
- c) **In Vitro Fertilization (IVF) with Embryo Transfer (ET)** – After a woman is stimulated to produce more eggs, the eggs are aspirated and kept in the laboratory. A sperm sample is taken from the husband and the quality sperm is placed with the aspirated eggs to allow for natural fertilization in a laboratory environment. The resulting embryos are placed back into the uterus of the woman for potential implantation.
- d) **Intracytoplasmic Sperm Injection (ICSI)** – A single sperm is injected into an egg. The resulting embryos are usually after 3-5 days transferred into the uterus of a woman for potential implantation.
- e) **Assisted hatching (AH)** – AH involves thinning or making a small hole in the layer that surrounds the embryo to allow it a better chance of hatching and implanting in the uterus.
